Subject: Fire Restrictions, Forest Order No. 14-16-03

I have decided to issue a Forest Order to implement fire restrictions on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest as described in FSH 5109.18.

The purpose of fire restrictions is to reduce the risk of human-caused fires on National Forest land and the associated damage and cost. The following information from Predictive Services indicates:

- 1000-hr dead fuel moistures for the northwestern mountains are dropping and below average for this time of year.
- The current energy release component (ERC's) are tracking above average and trending upward.
- The average burning index (BI) for the Shasta-Trinity National Forest has consistently been in the upper 50s.

The decision to implement fire restrictions is largely due to rapidly increasing fire behavior indices including burning index (BI) and decreasing 1000-hr fuel moistures. I am exempting the areas immediately surrounding Shasta Lake, Trinity Lake, and Iron Canyon Reservoir because they are void of vegetation and risk of fire escape is minimal.

Fire Management on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest has coordinated with the Northern Operations Coordinator, local Cal Fire units and other Forests in the Province in recommending fire restriction implementation. Assessment factors include review of weather, fuel conditions and large fire behavior potential as well as fire suppression resource commitments and availability across the north state and region.

I have concluded that this decision may be categorically excluded from documentation in an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) or Environmental Assessment (EA) under the National Environmental Policy Act. This action falls within the category identified in 36 CFR 220.6(d)(1) – prohibitions to provide short-term resource protection or to protect public health and safety – and does not require documentation in a decision memo, decision notice, or record of decision. I have determined that there are no extraordinary circumstances associated with this temporary closure. Implementation of the decision may begin immediately.

**ORDER NO. 14-16-03
FIRE RESTRICTIONS
SHASTA-TRINITY NATIONAL FOREST**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety and protect natural resources, the following acts are prohibited within the Shasta-Trinity National Forest. This Order is effective from July 15, 2016 through the end of the official 2016 fire season.

1. Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire, except:
 - a. in the Developed Recreation Sites listed in Exhibit A
 - b. in the Designated Fire Safe Sites listed in Exhibit B, described in Exhibit D, and shown on the attached map,
 - c. within 10 feet of Shasta Lake, Trinity Lake, and Iron Canyon Reservoir, provided that the area is at least fifty feet from any vegetation, as shown on the attached map, and
 - d. in the Trinity Alps Wilderness Area, Yolla Bolly-Middle Eel Wilderness Area, Chanchelulla Wilderness Area, Castle Crags Wilderness Area, Mt. Shasta Wilderness Area, as shown on the attached map.

36 CFR 261.52(a).

2. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building; within the Developed Recreation Sites listed in Exhibit A; within the Designated Fire Safe Sites listed in Exhibit B, described in Exhibit D, and shown on the attached map; and within 10 feet of Shasta Lake, Trinity Lake, and Iron Canyon Reservoir, provided that the area is at least fifty feet from any vegetation, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.52(d).
3. Operating an internal combustion engine, except below the high waterline on Shasta Lake, Trinity Lake, and Iron Canyon Reservoir and on National Forest System roads and trails not listed in Exhibit C. 36 CFR 261.52(h).
4. Welding, or operating an acetylene or other torch with an open flame.
36 CFR 261.52(i).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:


1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission. Persons with a valid California Campfire Permit are not exempt from the prohibitions listed above. However, persons with a valid California Campfire Permit may use portable stoves or lanterns using gas, jellied petroleum, or pressurized liquid fuel.

2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons with a valid fuelwood-cutting permit from the Shasta-Trinity National Forest may operate a chainsaw, provided that the cutting is done in compliance with the terms of the permit.
4. Persons may operate a generator if the person is in attendance at all times the generator is being used, the generator has a working USDA Forest Service approved spark arrestor, and the generator is being used in an area that is barren and cleared of all flammable material in at least 5 feet in all directions.


These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.


