

**ORDER NO. 16-08**  
**PINE FIRE CLOSURE**  
**LOS PADRES NATIONAL FOREST**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Ojai and Mt. Pinos Ranger Districts of the Los Padres National Forest. This Order is effective from July 16, 2016 until the Pine Fire is fully suppressed.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Pine Fire Closure Area. The Pine Fire Closure Area boundary begins at the intersection of Forest Trail No. 23W04 and Reyes Creek, then continues north along Reyes Creek to its intersection with Forest Road No. 7N11, then continues east along Forest Road 7N11 to its intersection with Alamo Creek, then continues east along Alamo Creek to its intersection with Forest Trail No. 21W05, then continues south along Forest Trail No. 21W05 to its intersection with Forest Trail No. 21W10, then continues south along Forest Trail No. 21W10 to its intersection with Pine Mountain Ridge, then continues west along Pine Mountain Ridge back to the starting point, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.53(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Pine Fire Closure Area, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.55(a).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Owners or lessees of land in the Fire Closure Area, to the extent necessary access their land.
3. Residents in the Fire Closure Area, to the extent necessary to access their residences.
4. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
