**FIRE CLOSURE
Saddle Fire Incident**

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on the roads and trails described in this order, on the Pine Valley Ranger District, Dixie National Forest until further notice:

1. To be upon the trails and roads described below, which are closed for the protection of public health and safety. [Title 36 CFR 261.53(e)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempted from the prohibition contained in this Order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order. [Title 36 CFR 261.50(d)(1)]
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer; or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. [Title 36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)]
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

ROADS AND TRAILS DESCRIBED:

The closed roads and trails are depicted on the map attached as Exhibit A, and specifically described as follows:

- Goat Springs Trail, # 31016. T39S, R15W, Section 14, 15, 16, 20, 21, 29 and 32.
- Forsyth Trail, T39S, R15W, Section 14, 23, 26, 35 and T40S, R15W, Section 2.
- Road # 2113, 2114, 3396 and 565. T39S, R15W, Section 1, 12 and T39S, R14W, Section 6.

PURPOSE/DURATION:

This order is temporary and is intended for public safety during wildland fire operations.

IMPLEMENTATION:



1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until August 1, 2016 or rescinded, whichever occurs first.
2. A map identifying the areas that may be restricted is attached and made part of this order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581(b)(7)}.
4. Further information regarding this order may be obtained at the Pine Valley Ranger District office located in St. George, Utah, telephone number (435) 652-3100, and at the Dixie National Forest Supervisor's Office in Cedar City, Utah, telephone number (435) 865-3700
5. This order supersedes any previous order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this order in the areas covered by this order.
