**AREA CLOSURE  
*Pioneer Fire – Version #1  
For Public Safety***

**PROHIBITIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited on all lands as described in this order, within the Idaho City Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.

1. Going into or being upon the area as described in this order. **36 CFR 261.52(e)**

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order;
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

**AREA DESCRIPTION:**

**The Pioneer Fire Closure Area** is described as all National Forest System (NFS) lands (including all roads and trails within the area) within the following boundary - beginning in Idaho City at the Junction of NFS Road #314 (Bear Run Road) and Road #307 (Main Street in Idaho City) located in Township 6 North, Range 5 East, Section 26; continuing easterly along, **but not including** NFS Road #314 to Meadow Drive (Duquette Pines Subdivision Road); continuing Northeasterly along, **and including**, NFS Road #314 to the junction with NFS Road #380 (Near Pilot Peak) located in Township 7 North, Range 6 East, Section 1; continuing northerly, then westerly, then southerly along, **and including**, NFS Road #380 to NFS Road #399 located in Township 7 North, Range 5 East, Section 2; continuing southerly along, **and including**, NFS Road #399 to NFS Road #399B located in Township 7 North, Range 5 East, Section 33; continuing easterly along, **and including**, NFS Road #399B to the roads terminus located in Township 7 North, Range 5 East, Section 26; continuing due South to NFS Road #319 (Deer Creek Road) located in Township 7 North, Range 5 East, Section 35; continuing southerly along, **and including**, NFS Road #319 to NFS Road #379 (Elk Creek Road) located in Township 6 North, Range 5 East, Section 11; continuing southerly along, **and including**, NFS Road #379 to the road's intersection with NFS Road 379G (Spanish Fork Road) located in Township 6

North, Range 5 East, Southern edge of Section 14; continuing southerly along, **but not including**, NFS road #379 to NFS Road #307 (Main Street); continuing southerly along, **but not including**, NFS road #307 back to the point of origin.

The above described Area (including all roads and trails within the Area) are located on National Forest System lands within the administrative and proclaimed boundaries of the Idaho City Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Boise County, Idaho, Boise Meridian.


**PURPOSE:**

The area as described above has ongoing wildfire activity (Pioneer Fire). This area is closed for public safety and protection from hazards associated with wildfire.

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.
4. Violation of the above prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. 16 U.S.C. §551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3571(b)(6), 3581 (b)(7).
5. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the areas (and/or roads, trails) covered by this Order.


