FOREST ORDER NO. 06-03-03-16-03

TRAIL CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on Middle Trail No. 26 on the Mt. Adams Ranger District of the Gifford Pinchot National Forest as described below and shown on the attached map. This Order is effective beginning July 22, 2016 until August 22, 2016, unless rescinded.

1. Using any type of vehicle prohibited by the order. [36 CFR 261.55(b)]

It is prohibited to operate any motorized vehicle on Middle Trail No. 26 beginning at the point of intersection with National Forest System Road No. 8800100 to the trailhead on National Forest System Road No. 2400230 at Surprise Lakes.

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.


These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violations of these prohibitions is punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC § 551; 18 USC § 3559 and 18USC § 3571).
