FIRE RESTRICTION ORDER

Stage II Fire Restrictions

**PROHIBITIONS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area, roads, and trails as described in this order, all within the Spring Mountains National Recreation Area, Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest, beginning July 21, 2016 at 12:01 a.m. and continuing until further notice.

1. Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire, or stovefire.  
[36 CFR 261.52(a)]
2. Smoking, outside an enclosed vehicle or building.  
[36 CFR 261.52(d)]
3. Welding, or operating an acetylene torch with open flames.  
[36 CFR 261.52(i)]
4. Using, or causing to be used, any explosive.  
[36 CFR 261.52(b)]

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following is exempt from this order.

1. Portable stoves using gas, jellied petroleum or pressurized liquid fuel.
2. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
3. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of a organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

**PURPOSE**

To reduce the risk of human caused wildfires during periods of extreme fire danger and severe fire weather

**AREA DESCRIBED:**

All National Forest System Lands located within the boundaries of the Spring Mountain National Recreation Area, as shown on the attached map.

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This Order will be in effect beginning July 20, 2016 at 12:01am and shall remain in effect and shall remain in effect until September 30, 2016 or until rescinded, whichever is sooner.
2. Exhibit A, "Definitions," is attached and incorporated into this order.
3. Any violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than six months. [Title 16 USC § 551, Title 18 USC § 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC § 3581(b)(7)].

5. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the areas covered by this Order.

## EXHIBIT A

### STAGE II FIRE RESTRICTIONS

#### DEFINITIONS:


**DESIGNATED AREA:** Developed recreation sites such as (campgrounds and picnic areas) that are maintained and administered by the Forest Service, shown on the current Forest visitor maps, and are equipped with permanent fire structures.

**FIRE STRUCTURE:** A permanent metal or concrete structure, which is specifically designed for the purpose of containing a campfire or cooking fire that has been installed and maintained by the Forest Service or equivalent.

**STOVE FIRE:** A fire built inside a fully enclosed metal stove, grill, or sheep herder type stove, which is outfitted with a chimney that is at least five (5) feet in length and is equipped with a spark arrestor consisting of a mesh screen with a screen opening of ¼ inch or less.

**CHAIN SAW:** A saw powered by an internal combustion engine, with cutting teeth linked in an endless chain.
