ON THE POWDERHORN TRAIL #15E15, FROM IT'S JUNCTION WITH FOREST ROAD #03 TO THE BOUNDARY OF THE GRANITE CHIEF WILDERNESS.

ON THE FIVE LAKES TRAIL #16E13, FROM IT'S JUNCTION WITH ALPINE MEADOWS COUNTY ROAD TO THE BOUNDARY OF THE GRANITE CHIEF WILDERNESS.
