

PUBLIC NOTICE

TAHOE NATIONAL FOREST

LITTLE TRUCKEE RESTRICTED USE AREA

Order No. 17-95-199

PURSUANT TO TITLE 36 CFR 261.50(a), I PROHIBIT ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ACTS ON NATIONAL FOREST LANDS IN THE LITTLE TRUCKEE RESTRICTED USE AREA AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT 1:

1. CAMPING OUTSIDE OF DESIGNATED CAMPGROUNDS. 36 CFR 261.58(e).
2. BUILDING, MAINTAINING, ATTENDING, OR USING A FIRE, CAMPFIRE, OR STOVE FIRE OUTSIDE DESIGNATED CAMPGROUNDS. 36 CFR 261.52(a).

FURTHER, I PROHIBIT THE FOLLOWING ACTS WITHIN THE LITTLE TRUCKEE SUMMIT AND PROSSER HILL STAGING AREAS AS POSTED ON THE GROUND AND SHOWN ON EXHIBIT 1:


1. CAMPING, BETWEEN APRIL 15 AND NOVEMBER 15 OF EACH CALENDAR YEAR. 36 CFR 261.58(a).
2. CAMPING IN EXCESS OF SEVEN CONSECUTIVE DAYS, BETWEEN NOVEMBER 16 AND APRIL 14 OF EACH CALENDAR YEAR. 36 CFR 261.58(a).

THESE PROHIBITIONS ARE IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL PROHIBITIONS IN 36 CFR 261.
