

FOREST DEVELOPMENT TRAILS

TAHOE NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited within the Tahoe National Forest.

Using a motorized vehicle or bicycle on the forest development trails listed below:

- a. Granite Chief Trail (15E23) from its intersection with the Pacific Crest National Scenic Trail in Section 26, T.16N., R.15E., MDB&M, to the northeast one-quarter of Section 25, T.16N., R.15E., MDB&M, as shown on the attached map (Exhibit A); and
- b. Painted Rock Trail (15E06) from its intersection with the Pacific Crest National Scenic Trail in Section 23, T.16N., R.15E., MDB&M, to the southwest one-quarter of Section 9, T.16N., R.15E., MDB&M, as shown on the attached map (Exhibit A);


36 CFR 261.55(b).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.


This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.


