

ORDER NO. 17-00-229

SPECIAL CLOSURE
TAHOE NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), and in order to protect the bald eagle the following acts are prohibited within the Tahoe National Forest:


1. Going into or being upon portions of the southwest 1/4 of Section 5, the west 1/2 of Section 8 and east 1/2 of Section 7, T19N, R8E, MDM, as shown on the attached map (Exhibit A). This closure is effective January 1 through August 31 annually, based on presence of bald eagles as determined by a Forest Service Wildlife Biologist and duly posted. 36 CFR 261.53(a).
2. Landing of any watercraft on the shores of National Forest Lands shown in Exhibit A. This closure is effective January 1 through August 31 annually, based on presence of bald eagles as determined by a Forest Service Wildlife Biologist and duly posted. 36 CFR 261.53 (a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the prohibitions contained in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571.


