**ORDER**

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 261.50(b) the following acts are prohibited on designated portions of National Forest Service Roads and Trails, as shown on the attached map, within the Idaho Panhandle National Forests. These restrictions are in addition to those general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR, Part 261, Subpart A, become effective **July 22, 2016**, and will remain in effect until rescinded.

1. Using or being on the trail [Title 36 CFR 261.55(a)]
2. Prohibited to go into or be upon any area which is closed for the protection of Public Health and Safety. [Title 36 CFR 261.53(e)]

**Forest Trail 103 from Forest boundary to junction of Trail 101 during the time in which active timber harvest operations are in progress in the area.**

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt:

1. Persons with specific written authorization for the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official emergency duty. Report all emergency access to the Coeur d'Alene River Ranger District at (208) 664-2318.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.
4. Contractor and his personnel in the performance of their duties.


**RATIONALE:** These restrictions are promulgated for **PUBLIC HEALTH and SAFETY during felling and aviation operations while harvesting timber. Timber felling will be occurring and Aircraft will be flying near these locations carrying sling loads of logs.**

**PENALTY:** Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571)

**NOTIFICATION:** A copy of this order shall be posted in the Forest Supervisor's Office, each District Ranger's office and other appropriate locations as prescribed under Title 36 CFR 261.51.
