**SPECIAL ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR
UINTA-WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FOREST
EVANSTON/MT. VIEW RANGER DISTRICTS**

TEMPORARY ROAD/TRAIL CLOSURE

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), **the following acts are prohibited** on the National Forest System roads and trail described in this Order. All lands affected are located on the Evanston/Mt. View Ranger District, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest. This order is in effect until further notice.

1. Being in or upon Forest Service road #608 including Forest Service trail #903 and Forest Service roads #112, #365, #087 and 153 as described below and shown on attached map. [36 CFR 261.53 (e)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

Forest Service road #608 including OHV trail (Forest Service trail #903) is closed to the junction of Forest Service roads #112/#365 on the east and Forest Service road #608 is closed to the junction with Forest Service roads #087 and #153 on the west, approximately a distance of 2.5 miles, located Township 2 North, Range 14 East, Sections 4, 10, 11, 2, and 3 all located in the Salt Lake Base Meridian as shown on map.

PURPOSE:

Purpose of the closure is to provide for public health and safety during fire suppression efforts of the Outlook fire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. Attached map shows the area affected by this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual, or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6 months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581(b)(7)].
