

ORDER
SUNFLOWER and IKE FIRES TEMPORARY CLOSURE
KAIBAB NATIONAL FOREST
WILLIAMS RANGER DISTRICT

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and/or (b), the following acts are prohibited in areas as described in this Order on National Forest System lands administered by the Kaibab National Forest, Williams Ranger District in Coconino County in the State of Arizona. The restricted area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Being in an area, 36 CFR 261.53 (e)
2. Being on a trail, 36 CFR 261.55 (a)
3. Being on a road, 36 CFR 251.54(e)

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and,
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

AREA DESCRIBED:

The boundary of the closure area is North of Forest Roads (FR) 110 and 109, East of FR 747 and Big Spring Wash, then South of FR 139 and West of FR 109.

PURPOSE:

This order is needed for public safety due to the Sunflower and Ike Fires.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until September 15, 2016, or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.

Violation of this Order is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals and \$10,000.00 for organizations, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3885, Title 18 USC 3571, and Title 18 USC 3581].
