

**ORDER  
USDA - FOREST SERVICE  
COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST  
RED ROCK RANGER DISTRICT  
POINT FIRE TEMPORARY CLOSURE**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in areas as described in this Order on National Forest System lands administered by the Coconino National Forest, in Coconino and Yavapai Counties, Arizona, and as depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

**PROHIBITIONS:**

1. Going into or being upon the restricted area; 36 CFR 261.53(e)
2. Being on a trail; 36 CFR 261.55(a)

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
2. Person(s) with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

**AREA DESCRIBED:**

The order applies to National Forest System lands, roads, and trails within the following boundary: Munds Mountain and Lee Mountain above 5800 feet in elevation; all of Jacks Canyon Trail; all of Munds Mountain Trail; and the Jacks Canyon trailhead.

This area, roads, and trail closure only affects National Forest System lands within the closure area on the Coconino National Forest. The closure does not affect private, state, county, or other Non-National Forest land within the closure boundary.


**PURPOSE:**

This order is needed to protect public health and safety due to firefighting within the Point Fire area.

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until August 14, 2016 or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.
2. This Order rescinds, replaces and supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in that area addressed by Exhibit A.
