The Soberanes Fire Closure Area begins at the northwest corner of Section 1, Township 17 South, Range 1 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian and continues east along and following the National Forest boundary to Tassajara Road (Forest Road 18S02), south to China Camp and the Pine Ridge Trailhead, west along the Pine Ridge Trail (Forest Trail 3E06) to the Pine Ridge Trailhead and Los Padres National Forest boundary, northwest along State Highway 1 to the Los Padres National Forest boundary and north following the Los Padres National Forest boundary to the point of beginning, as shown on the attached map.

**EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b) and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited in the Monterey Ranger District within the Los Padres National Forest. This Order is effective from July 26, 2016 until the Soberanes Fire is declared out.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System Lands within the Soberanes Fire Closure Areas described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B. 36 CFR 261.52(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Soberanes Fire Closure Area as shown on Exhibit B. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
3. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Soberanes Fire Closure Area as shown on Exhibit B. 36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State or Local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
3. Owners or lessees of private land within the Soberanes Fire Closure Area, to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.
4. Persons who reside within the Soberanes Fire Closure Area are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent necessary to gain access to their residences.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.


