



ORDER 06-18-03-16-08

EMERGENCY ROAD CLOSURE FOR PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY

**WILLAMETTE NATIONAL FOREST
Sweet Home Ranger District**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the trail described in this order within the administrative authority of the Willamette National Forest. This order will become effective upon signature, and will expire on August 5th, 2016.

PROHIBITION:

(1) Being on a road closed for public health and safety.

§36 CFR 261.55(a)

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR §261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Any person with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local official or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (3) Contractor performing work for USFS.

DESCRIPTION OF TRAIL CLOSURE:

- Forest road 2025 from the junction of the 500 spur to the end of the road
- See Attached map (Exhibit A).

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for a corporation or imprisonment for not more than six months or both. Title 16 USC Section 551.



