


Grizzly Bear



Black Bear



Color and Size can be misleading.
Look for a combination of characteristics.

Grizzly Bear

- **Color** varies from blond to black.
- **Distinctive shoulder hump.**
- **Rump** is lower than shoulder hump.
- **Face profile** appears dished-in between eyes and snout.
- **Ears** are short and rounded.
- **Front claws** are 2-4 inches long, slightly curved. Claw marks are **usually** visible in tracks.

Black Bear

- **Color** varies from blond to black.
- **No distinctive shoulder hump.**
- **Rump** is higher than front shoulders.
- **Face profile** is straight.
- **Ears** are tall and pointed.
- **Front claws** are less than 2 inches long and curved. Claw marks are **not** usually visible in tracks.
