

PUBLIC NOTICE

TAHOE NATIONAL FOREST

BULLARDS BAR RESTRICTED USE AREA

Order No. 17-95-203

PURSUANT TO TITLE 36 CFR 261.50(a), I PROHIBIT ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ACTS ON NATIONAL FOREST LANDS OUTSIDE OF DEVELOPED RECREATION SITES IN THE BULLARDS BAR RESTRICTED USE AREA AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT 1, EXCEPT WHEN THE RESERVOIR DRAWDOWN IS FIFTEEN (15) FEET OR GREATER AND IS AUTHORIZED BY PERMIT:


1. CAMPING. 36 CFR 261.58(e).
2. BUILDING, MAINTAINING, ATTENDING, OR USING A FIRE, CAMPFIRE, OR STOVE FIRE. 36 CFR 261.52(a).

CAMPING PERMITS ARE ISSUED BY THE YUBA COUNTY WATER AGENCY FOR OVERNIGHT CAMPING WITHIN THE RESTRICTED USE AREA AND MUST BE IN POSSESSION WHEN USING THE AREA FOR OVERNIGHT PURPOSES, CAMPING PERMITS AUTHORIZE CAMPING WITHIN THE BOAT ACCESS CAMPGROUNDS OR THE FORMERLY INUNDATED LANDS ONLY.

THE AREA SUBJECT TO THE ABOVE RESTRICTIONS IS GENERALLY DESCRIBED AS; THOSE LANDS IN THE TAHOE NATIONAL FOREST FROM THE EDGE OF THE CURRENT WATER SURFACE OF BULLARDS BAR RESERVOIR TO THE RIDGE TOP OF THE SURROUNDING SLOPES AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT 1.

THESE PROHIBITIONS ARE IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL PROHIBITIONS IN 36 CFR 261.




