

PUBLIC NOTICE

TAHOE NATIONAL FOREST FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS

Order No. 17-95-183

PURSUANT TO TITLE 36 CFR 261.50(b), I PROHIBIT THE FOLLOWING ACT ON FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROAD NUMBER 18-20 (WINDY POINT ROAD), AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT 1.

1. BEING ON ROAD WHEN CLOSED BY A SIGN OR GATE. 36 CFR 261.54(e).

THE FOLLOWING PERSONS ARE EXEMPT:

1. ANY FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL OFFICER OR MEMBER OF ANY ORGANIZED RESCUE OR FIRE FIGHTING FORCE OR EMPLOYEE OF A PUBLIC UTILITY IN THE PERFORMANCE OF AN OFFICIAL DUTY.
2. PERSONS WITH A PERMIT ISSUED BY THE DISTRICT RANGER. THIS PERMIT MUST BE IN THEIR POSSESSION AT ALL TIMES WHEN ACCESSING THIS ROAD.

THESE PROHIBITIONS ARE IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL PROHIBITIONS IN 36 CFR 261.


