

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## TAHOE NATIONAL FOREST FULLER LAKE RESTRICTED USE AREA ORDER NO. 17-95-177

PURSUANT TO 36 CFR 261.50(a), I PROHIBIT ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ACTS ON NATIONAL FOREST LANDS OUTSIDE OF DEVELOPED OR DESIGNATED RECREATION SITES IN THE FULLER LAKE RESTRICTED USE AREA AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT 1:


1. CAMPING. 36 CFR 261.58(e).
2. BUILDING, MAINTAINING, ATTENDING, OR USING A FIRE, CAMPFIRE, OR STOVE FIRE. 36 CFR 261.52(a).

THE FULLER LAKE RESTRICTED USE AREA IS GENERALLY DESCRIBED AS:

The National Forest lands East of Fuller Lake, located in the SW 1/4, SE 1/4, Sec. 8, T.17 N., R.12 E., MDM., and the National Forest lands within 1/4 mile of the West shore of Fuller Lake, located in the S 1/2, SW 1/4, Sec. 8, T.17 N., R.12 E., MDM., as shown on exhibit 1.

THESE PROHIBITIONS ARE IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL PROHIBITIONS CONTAINED IN 36 CFR PART 261.
