

Indian Peaks Wilderness Permit Application

Complete one form per trip (one or multiple consecutive nights) in its entirety to receive a permit

- A \$5.00 permit is required for each backpacking trip per group for overnight camping in the Indian Peaks Wilderness Area between June 1 and September 15. The fee covers the group and the Arapaho National Recreation Area use fee.
- Day and overnight permits are required year round for Outfitters/Guides and large groups (8 to 12 people). Inquire by calling either the Boulder or Sulphur Ranger District offices at the numbers listed below.
- To receive a permit in person with cash, check or card: print and complete this application and bring it to the Boulder or Granby office with your \$5.00 per trip payment.
- Mailed applications are also acceptable. Please send in the completed application(s) with one check or money order made payable to USDA Forest Service. Mail to either address below.
- **Allow two weeks to receive your permit by mail.**
