


# Wolfy Salvage Sale Area and Slash Disposal Map

Cutting Units: ALL



Residual Purchaser created slash should be evenly distributed throughout the harvest unit and lopped and scattered to a height of 2 feet or less. The materials should be well distributed throughout cutting units and may be deposited on skid trails.

Any logging slash at landings adjacent to system roads 6 inches or larger small end DOB shall be cut to a maximum length of 8 feet and decked by piling pieces parallel to each other to a maximum height of 5 feet.

Logging slash at landings 6 inches or smaller small end DOB shall be scattered in cut unit areas adjacent to landings to a height of 2 feet or less.

All trees less than 8 inches DBH, over 5 feet in height, and damaged beyond recovery by Purchaser's Operations shall be felled. Such trees shall be limbed to a stem diameter outside bark of approximately 3 inches, at which point the top shall be cut from the remainder of the stem, and shall be bucked into lengths not exceeding 20 feet.
