Watch Out for Heavy Equipment Working *Between Porcupine Creek & Cold Creek Roads*

Kalispell, MT. August 12, 2016 -During August and September a gravel crushing and aggregate laydown project will be occurring off of Hwy. #83 in the Swan Valley between Porcupine Creek Road #10229 and Cold Creek Road #903. The purpose of the project is to improve road drainage, provide a maintainable road surface and improve user comfort on roads open to public traffic.

When the project is occurring, the public is advised to slow down and watch for advance warning signs, construction equipment and heavy truck traffic working on the following roads: Gravel crushing operation will occur at the existing Porcupine Pit located approximately 0.4 miles off of Swan Hwy. #83 and Road #10229. Gravel hauling and laydown will occur on the first 2 miles of Lion Creek Road #9769; Piper Creek Road #966 from Hwy. #83 to the Piper Creek Trailhead; the entire length of Peck Lake Road #888 from Piper Creek Road to Cold Creek Road; Cold Creek Road #903 from Hwy. #83 to its intersection with Jim Lakes Road #9568; and Jim Lakes Road #9568 from its beginning to its intersection with Cold Lakes Trailhead Road #9599.
