STAGE I FIRE RESTRICTIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (a), the following acts are prohibited outside of designated Wilderness Areas as depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A (the "Restricted Area"), within the Shoshone National Forest.

**PROHIBITIONS:**

1. Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire. [36 C.F.R. § 261.52 (a)]
2. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site, or while stopped at least three feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable materials. [36 C.F.R. § 261.52 (d)]

**EXEMPTIONS:** Pursuant to **36 CFR 261.50(e)** the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force when in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons using a Forest Service provided metal campfire ring in a Developed Recreation Site.
3. Persons using a device solely fueled by liquid petroleum or LPG fuels that can be turned on and off. Such devices can only be used in an area that is barren or cleared of all overhead and surrounding flammable materials within 3 feet of device.
4. Any person with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

**AREA DESCRIBED:** National Forest System lands as depicted on Exhibit A.

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this order is to reduce risk of human-caused wildfires during periods of high fire danger and severe fire weather conditions.

**IMPLEMENTATION**

1. This Order will be in effect at noon on August 12, 2016 and shall remain in effect until rescinded.

## Exhibit A

Any violation of this Order is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571 (b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
