

PUBLIC NOTICE

TAHOE NATIONAL FOREST NORTH YUBA RESTRICTED USE AREA

Order No. 17-95-204

PURSUANT TO TITLE 36 CFR 261.50(a) & (b), I PROHIBIT ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ACTS ON NATIONAL FOREST LANDS IN THE NORTH YUBA RESTRICTED USE AREA AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT 1:

1. CAMPING OUTSIDE OF DESIGNATED CAMPGROUNDS. 36 CFR 261.58(e).
2. BUILDING, MAINTAINING, ATTENDING, OR USING A FIRE, CAMPFIRE, OR STOVE FIRE OUTSIDE OF DESIGNATED CAMPGROUNDS OR PICNIC AREAS. 36 CFR 261.52(a).
3. CAMPING IN EXCESS OF 14 NIGHTS, CUMULATIVE, PER YEAR IN ALL *FREE* CAMPGROUNDS. 36 CFR 261.58(a).
4. HAVING MORE THAN SIX (6) PERSONS OCCUPY A SINGLE CAMPING SITE. 36 CFR 261.58(F).
5. PARKING IN EXCESS OF TWO HOURS IN PULL-OUT ON SOUTH SIDE OF STATE HIGHWAY 49 AT SIERRA COUNTY MILE POST 4.58. 36 CFR 261.58(g).

THE EXTERIOR BOUNDARIES OF THE NORTH YUBA RESTRICTED USE AREA AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT 1 ARE GENERALLY DESCRIBED AS:

A 1/4 mile wide strip along both sides of State Highway 49, from the Sierra County line at Depot Hill, to the North Yuba River, then along the North Yuba River extending from a point 1/4 mile from Cherokee Creek (Section 13, T.19 N., R.8 E., MDM) upstream to the summit of Yuba Pass (Section 11, T.20 N., R.13 E., MDM).

A 1/4 mile wide strip along both sides of Haypress Creek beginning from its confluence with the North Yuba River and continuing upstream to Milton Creek (Section 26, T.20 N., R.12 E., MDM).

A 1/4 mile wide strip along both sides of Salmon Creek from its confluence with the North Yuba and upstream to its confluence with Packer Creek (Sections 3 & 10, T.20 N., R.12 E., MDM).

Packer Creek Road terminating at Packer Lodge (Section 5, T.20 N., R.12 E., MDM).

Sardine Lake Road (Sections 3, 9 & 10, T.20 N., R.12 E., MDM).

Mountain House Road from Goodyears Bar to the first switchback (Section 8, T.19 N., R.10 E., MDM).

A 1/4 mile wide strip around the perimeter of Upper Salmon Lake (Section 29, T.21 N., R.12 E., MDM).

A 1/4 mile wide strip around the perimeter of Lower Sardine Lake (Sections 9 & 10, T.20 N., R.12 E., MDM).

THESE PROHIBITIONS ARE IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL PROHIBITIONS IN 36 CFR 261.
