Taylor Creek Bridge Re-Opened

CECILVILLE, CA- The USDA Forest Service announced that repair has been completed for the Salmon-Taylor Bridge across Taylor Creek, near the community of Cecilville, California. August 15, 2016 the bridge was re-opened for vehicle and pedestrian traffic. The bridge is located on Taylor Creek Road, 0.1 mile from the Cecilville Road (Forest Route 93), within the Klamath National Forest and provides access to the Poison Trailhead into Trinity Alps wilderness. .
