**BRIGGS  
FIRE AREA CLOSURE**

**PROHIBITIONS:**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited in the areas and on the roads and trails described below, on the Beaver Ranger District, Fishlake National Forest until further notice:

1. Going into or being upon the area described below which is closed for the protection of public health and safety. [36 CFR 261.53(e)]
2. Being on the roads described below. [36 CFR 261.54(e)]
3. Being on the trails described below. [36 CFR 261.55(a)]

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempted from the prohibitions contained in this Order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order. [36 CFR 261.50(d)(1)]
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer; or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. [Title 36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)]
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

**AREA, ROADS AND TRAILS DESCRIBED:**

**The boundaries of the closed area are depicted on the attached map, and are specifically described as follows:**

- Beginning at the intersection of the Fishlake National Forest Boundary and FS road 2354 in T. 28 S., R. 6 W., Sec. 28, then going east on FS road 2354 to FS trail 062, and along trail 062 to the junction of FS trail 058, along FS trail 058 to the junction with FS trail 064, south along FS trail 064 to the junction of FS trail 222, south along FS trail 222 to FS road 584, along FS road 584 to Highway 153; Following Hwy 153 south west to FS road 124. Following FS road 124 west to Paiute Side Trail 05; Following Paiute Side Trail 05 west to the Forest Boundary. North on the forest boundary to the beginning at FS road 2354 (T28S R6W Sec 28)

**The closed trails and roads are described as follows:**

Trail Number 063 (Van Fleet)

Trail Number 163 (Lousy Jims)  
Trail Number 223 (Bosman trail to the head of Duncan Creek connector)  
Road Number 987 (Spur overlook)  
Road Number 752

**The following roads and trails are boundaries to the area closure and are open to pass through traffic, and therefore are not closed by this Order:**

Trail Number PST 05 and Road Number 124 (The Face Trail and Jimmy Reed Road)  
Trail Number 062 (South Fork of North Creek Trail)  
Trail Number 058 (Bosman Creek Trail)  
Trail Number 064 (South Fork of North Creek Rim Trail)  
Trail Number 222 (Duncan Creek Trail)  
Road Number 584 (Duncan Creek Trail Head)

**PURPOSE/DURATION:**

This Order is temporary and is intended for public safety during wildland fire operations.

**IMPLEMENTATION:**


1. This order will be in effect when signed at the point of restriction, beginning September 16, 2016, and shall remain in effect until October 15, 2016 or until rescinded, whichever is sooner.
2. A map identifying the closed area is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or Imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [16 USC 551, 18 USC 3571(b) (6), 18 USC 3581(b)(7)}.
4. Further information regarding this Order may be obtained at the Beaver Ranger District office located in Beaver, Utah telephone number (435) 438-2436, and at the Fishlake National Forest Supervisor's Office in Richfield, Utah, telephone number (435) 896-9233.
5. This Order supersedes any previous order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this order in the areas covered by this Order.
