

Meadow Gorge Salvage Sale Area Report

The Meadow Gorge Salvage Timber Sale is located in and around the Meadow Creek and Gorge Creek Trailheads, 8 miles south of the Spotted Bear District Office, Flathead National Forest. Approximately 72 CCF (36 MBF) of non-saw roundwood will be offered for sale.

TIMS Number: 16406

Marking and Cruising: All designated standing dead and down timber was marked and cruised by the Hungry Horse/Spotted Bear pre-sale crew in May 2016.

Logging Systems: Unit 1: 27 acres – ground-based with an average skid distance of 200’.

Sale Area: 677 acres

Hauling distance to nearest mill: 79 miles (56 miles gravel, 13 miles pavement)

Appraisal: Standard Rate = \$1.00/ccf. Total sale value: \$72

Performance Bond: \$100
