**SPECIAL ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR
UINTA-WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FOREST
SALT LAKE RANGER DISTRICT**

TEMPORARY TRAIL AND AREA CLOSURE

PROHIBITION:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and 36 CFR 261.50(b), **the following acts are prohibited** on the National Forest System trails and area described in this order. The trails and areas affected are located within the Salt Lake Ranger District, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest. This order is in effect starting Monday, August 22, 2016 at 12:01a.m. until Wednesday, August 24, 2016 at 12:01a.m.

- 1. Being in or upon the trail and/or area** as described below and shown on attached map.
[36 CFR 261.55(a)] [36 CFR 261.53(e)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this order.
2. Any Federal, state or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIPTION:

The Broads Fork Trail (Forest Service trail #150) the entire trail starting from Big Cottonwood Canyon, Utah State Route 190 going south to the end of the trail located in Township 2 South, Range 2 East, Sections 21, PB53, 28 and 27 all located within the Salt Lake Base Meridian as shown on the attached map.

Area closure including the entire Mill B South Trail (Forest Service trail #151) and surrounding areas located in Township 2 South, Range 2 East, Sections 22, 23, PB 54, PB 56, 27, and 26 all located within the Salt Lake Base Meridian as shown on the attached map.

PURPOSE:

Purpose of the closure is to provide for public health and safety during fire burnout operations on the Mineral Fork fire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. Attached map shows the area affected by this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6 months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b) (6), Title 18 USC 3581(b) (7)].

5. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the area covered by this Order.
