

The Eldorado National Forest is soliciting competitive offers for the Pilliken Forest Health Stewardship Project. Pilliken Forest Health Stewardship Project is located within T.10.N., R.14.E., T.10.N., R.15.E., T.11.N., R.14. E., T.11.N., R.15.E., M.D.B.&M. Sealed – “Best Value” offers will be received at the Forest Supervisor's Office at 2:00 PM local time on Thursday, September 22, 2016 for an estimated 61,116 Tons (9,039 M board feet) of sawtimber marked or otherwise designated for cutting on 1,368.4 acres and one Mandatory stewardship project. The Mandatory Project #1 is Small Tree Thinning and Removal on 272.8 acres. Project #2 is Optional small tree thinning and removal on 53.9 acres and Project #3 is Optional tractor piling on 95.6 acres. Sale contains specified roads with an estimated public works construction cost of \$266,737.23. Bidders qualifying as small business concerns under the Small Business Act may, when submitting a bid, elect for the Forest Service to build permanent roads. The Forest Service will evaluate competitive offers submitted by offerors who present a price offer and technical proposal according to the information found under the section in the offer titled “Instructions to Offerors.” Evaluation factors for this project are technical approach, capability and past performance, utilization of local workforce, and price. One award will be made to the offeror whose proposal is technically acceptable and whose technical/price relationship is the “best value” to the Government.
