Remarks:

Today's plan of action is to patrol and monitor containment areas. Continue to mop-up to the extent necessary to minimize the likelihood of escape. Continue gridding for heat with the use of infrared heat detectors. Continue with fire suppression repair where appropriate. Provide initial attack resources to local district as needed.

Local Forest Service Type 4 Incident Commander will shadow Great Basin Team 3 today for transfer of command back to the unit on Wednesday, August 25, 2016.

Today, the weather will be mostly cloudy with a chance of afternoon dry thunderstorms. Temperatures will be cooler and conditions will remain dry. Winds will average about 10 mph with gusts up to 23 mph.

Since Great Basin Team 3 will be turning the fire over to the local unit, on Thursday, this will be the last update from us. We would like to thank the community of Salmon and all surrounding communities for all the support you have given the firefighting efforts.

Closures:

Area closure has been lifted.

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the prohibition listed in Order number 04-13-16-584 Stein Fire Emergency Area Closure Order, applicable to the North Fork Ranger District, Salmon-Challis National Forest, dated August 18th, 2016, and signed by Charles A. Mark, is hereby terminated.

Road closure now in effect.

Forest Service Road Number 071 (4th of July Creek Road) is closed beginning where Forest Service Land meets Private Land located at T24N, R22E, Section 21, continuing North and then to the West where FSR 071 intersects with FSR Number 256. FSR Number 071 is closed for its duration continuing to its end point near Stein Mountain located in T25N, R22E, Section 32. Please Note: FDR Number 071-A is also Closed.
