

ORDER NO. 0513-16-20

**SEQUOIA NATIONAL FOREST
WESTERN DIVIDE RANGER DISTRICT**

NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROAD CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(b), and to provide for public safety, the following act is prohibited within the Western Divide Ranger District of the Sequoia National Forest. This Order is effective from September 1, 2016 through August 31, 2017.

Being on Bace Ranch Road (Forest Road No. 20S92) from its intersection with County Road No. 220, then continuing northeast approximately 2 miles to the forest boundary in Section 3, Township 20 South, Range 30 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.54(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
