**ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR**  
**ORDER NUMBER KNF-08-06-00-15-23**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and for the protection of public health and safety and resources, the following act(s) is prohibited within the specified area(s). This order is effective from December 8, 2015 and ending December 8, 2020.

### **KISATCHIE NATIONAL FOREST**

#### **FIRE**

- 261.52(a) BUILDING, MAINTAINING, OR ATTENDING A FIRE ON ANY DESIGNATED ROAD, TRAIL, OR DEVELOPED PARKING AREA.
- 261.52(b) USING ANY TYPE OF EXPLOSIVE, WITHOUT WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION OF A FOREST OFFICER.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Any military, fire emergency, law enforcement or administrative vehicle when used for official or emergency purposes.
4. Employees of the Forest Service, United States Department of Agriculture in the performance of an official duty.
5. Any vehicle, whose use is expressly authorized by the Chief, Forest Service, under a permit, lease, license, or contract, shall be allowed.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of the prohibition set forth above is punishment by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment of not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571.

- 261.52(j) OPERATING OR USING ANY INTERNAL OR EXTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINE ON NATIONAL FOREST LANDS, WITHOUT A SPARK ARRESTING DEVICE PROPERLY INSTALLED, MAINTAINED AND IN EFFECTIVE WORKING ORDER MEETING EITHER, (1) DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, FOREST SERVICE STANDARD 5100-ia; OR (2) APPROPRIATE SOCIETY OF AUTOMOTIVE ENGINEERS (SAE) RECOMMEND PRACTICE J335(b) AND J35(a).

## **SPECIAL CLOSURES**

- 261.53(c) POSSESSION OR USE OF METAL DETECTOR, ELECTRONIC APPARATUS AND DEVICES FOR LOCATING METAL IS PROHIBITED FOR ANY PURPOSE UPON OR WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF ARCHEOLOGICAL, PREHISTORIC OR HISTORIC RESOURCES (AS DEFINED IN 36 CFR 261.2).
- 261.53(e) OPERATING OR USING A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT EMITS A NOISE IN EXCESS OF: NINETY-NINE (99) DECIBELS AT TWENTY (20) INCHES FROM THE EXHAUST OUTLET IN ACCORDANCE WITH SAE J1287, JUNE 1980.
- 261.54(c) USING A ROAD FOR COMMERCIAL HAULING WITHOUT A PERMIT, IF THE ROAD IS SIGNED AS REQUIRING A COMMERCIAL HAUL PERMIT.
- 261.54(d) OPERATING ON A FOREST TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM ROAD ANY MOTOR VEHICLE IN VIOLATION OF LOUISIANA STATE TRAFFIC CODE.
- 261.54(d) MOTOR VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED UP TO 50 FEET FROM THE EDGE OF THE ROAD SURFACE WHEN SAFE TO DO SO WITHOUT CAUSING DAMAGE TO NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM RESOURCES OR FACILITIES, UNLESS PROHIBITED BY STATE LAW, A TRAFIC SIGN OR AN ORDER.
- 261.54(f) OPERATING A VEHICLE CARELESSLY, RECKLESSLY, OR WITHOUT REGARD FOR THE RIGHTS OR SAFETY OF OTHER PERSONS OR IN A MANNER OR AT A SPEED THAT WOULD ENDANGER OR BE LIKELY TO ENDANGER ANY PERSON OR PROPERTY.
- 261.52(f) POSSESSING, DISCHARGING OR USING ANY KIND OF FIREWORK OR OTHER PYROTECHNIC DEVICE

## **FOREST DEVELOPMENT TRAILS**

- 261.55(c) POSSESSING OR USING A SADDLE, PACK, OR DRAFT ANIMAL ON ANY TRAIL NOT DESIGNATED FOR SUCH USE.

- 261.55(d) POSSESSING OR OPERATING ANY MOTORIZED VEHICLE IN EXCESS OF FIFTY (50) INCHES IN WIDTH, ON ANY DESIGNATED OFF-ROAD VEHICLE (OHV) TRAIL.
- 261.55(d) POSSESSING OR OPERATING ANY MOTORIZED VEHICLE WITH A TIRE LUG DEPTH GREATER THAN ONE INCH, ON OFF-ROAD OR DESIGNATED TRAILS.
- 261.55(d) OPERATING ANY MOTORIZED VEHICLE ON DESIGNATED MOTORIZED TRAILS OR ROADS DESIGNATED FOR VEHICLES LESS THAN OR EQUAL TO 50 INCHES WIDE FROM ONE HOUR AFTER SUNSET UNTIL ONE HOUR BEFORE SUNRISE.

## **WILDERNESS**

- 261.57(h) POSSESSING OR USING A WAGON, CART, OR OTHER VEHICLE, WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF A DESIGNATED WILDERNESS AREA.

## **OCCUPANCY/USE**

- 261.58(a) CAMPING SHALL BE LIMITED TO A PERIOD OF TIME NOT TO EXCEED 14 CONSECUTIVE DAYS IN THE FOLLOWING IDENTIFIED SITES: CANEY LAKE RECREATION AREA, CORNEY LAKE RECREATION AREA, CANE CAMP, CORRAL CAMP, ENDURO CAMPGROUND, FULLERTON CAMPGROUND, GUM SPRINGS RECREATION AREA, GUM SPRINGS HORSE TRAILHEAD, KINCAID CAMPGROUND, KISATCHIE BAYOU CAMPGROUND, LORAN CAMPGROUND, LOTUS CAMP, STUART LAKE CAMPGROUND, AND VALENTINE LAKE CAMPGROUND.

CAMPING OR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CAMPSITE SHALL BE LIMITED TO A PERIOD OF TIME NOT TO EXCEED 30 DAYS IN ALL OTHER CAMPGROUNDS AND THE GENERAL FOREST AREA.

AFTER THE 14 OR 30 DAY PERIOD, THE CAMPSITE MUST BE VACATED FOR A PERIOD OF 14 DAYS.

- 261.58(b) ENTERING OR USING A DEVELOPED RECREATION SITE OR PORTION THEREOF WHEN POSTED CLOSED.
- 261.58(e) CAMPING IN OR WITHIN 300 FEET OF ANY DEVELOPED PARKING AREA OR BOAT RAMP.
- 261.58(e) CAMPING WITHIN THE DESIGNATED BOUNDARIES OF A RED COCKADED WOODPECKER CLUSTER.

- 261.58(e) WHILE CAMPING IN A DEVELOPED CAMPGROUND IT IS PROHIBITED TO OPERATE AN ELECTRICAL GENERATOR BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 10:00 P.M. AND 7:00 A.M., EXCEPT IN DESIGNATED AREAS.
- 261.58(f) USE OF A DEVELOPED CAMPSITE WITH MORE THAN 8 PERSONS PER SINGLE SITE OCCUPANCY AND 16 PERSONS PER DOUBLE SITE OCCUPANCY.
- 261.58(g) PARKING OR LEAVING A VEHICLE IN VIOLATION OF POSTED INSTRUCTIONS.
- 261.58(h) PARKING OR LEAVING A VEHICLE OUTSIDE A PARKING SPACE ASSIGNED TO ONE'S OWN CAMP UNIT.
- 261.58(i) POSSESSING, PARKING, OR LEAVING MORE THAN TWO VEHICLES, EXCEPT MOTORCYCLES OR BICYCLES, PER CAMP UNIT.
- 261.58(j) BEING PUBLICLY NUDE.
- 261.58(k) SWIMMING OR BEING IN THE WATER WITHIN 100 FEET OF A DESIGNATED BOAT RAMP, BOAT DOCK, OR FISHING PIER, UNLESS LOADING OR UNLOADING A BOAT.
- 261.58(k) ENTERING OR BEING IN THE WATER AT DESIGNATED SWIM SITE BETWEEN 8:00 PM AND 8:00 AM
- 261.58(l) ENTERING OR BEING IN AREA DESIGNATED AS DAY USE ONLY BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8:00 PM AND 8:00 AM.
- 261.58(n) POSSESSING OR OPERATING A BOAT WITHIN A DESIGNATED SWIMMING AREA.
- 261.58(n) OPERATING A GAS POWER MOTORBOAT ON THE FOLLOWING FOREST SERVICE LAKES; VALENTINE, FULLERTON, STUART, AND GUM SPRINGS.
- 261.58(n) POSSESSION OR OPERATION OF A BOAT, MOTORBOAT, PERSONAL WATERCRAFT IN VIOLATION OF FEDERAL, STATE OR LOCAL LAWS.
- 261.58(o) WATER SKIING WITHIN 200 FEET OF A BOAT RAMP.
- 261.58(q) OPERATING ANY WATERCRAFT IN EXCESS OF A POSTED SPEED LIMIT. IDLE SPEED WITHIN 200 FEET OF PIERS AND BOAT RAMPS. (NO WAKE ZONES).

- 261.53(e) FOR THE PROTECTION OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY, IT IS PROHIBITED TO POSSESS A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE UNLESS SUCH SUBSTANCE WAS OBTAINED BY THE POSSESSOR DIRECTLY, OR PURSUANT TO A VALID PRESCRIPTION OR ORDER, FROM A PRACTITIONER ACTING IN THE COURSE OF PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE OR OTHERWISE ALLOWED BY FEDERAL OR STATE LAW.
- 261.53(e) FOR THE PROTECTION OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY, IT IS PROHIBITED TO POSSESS DRUG PARAPHERNALIA. CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE MEANS A DRUG OR OTHER SUBSTANCE OR IMMEDIATE PRECURSOR, INCLUDED IN SCHEDULES I, II, III, IV, OR V OF PART B OF THE CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT (21USC812) OR A DRUG OR SUBSTANCE ADDED TO THESE SCHEDULES PURSUANT TO THE TERMS OF THE ACT.
- DRUG PARAPHERNALIA MEANS ANY EQUIPMENT, PRODUCT, OR MATERIAL OF ANY KIND WHICH IS PRIMARILY INTENDED OR DESIGNED FOR USE IN MANUFACTURING, COMPOUNDING, CONVERTING, CONCEALING, PRODUCING, PROCESSING, PREPARING, INJECTING, INGESTING, INHALING, OR OTHERWISE INTRODUCING INTO THE HUMAN BODY A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE, POSSESSION OF WHICH IS UNLAWFUL UNDER THIS ORDER.
- 261.58(u) BEING IN THE AREA BETWEEN 10:00 P.M. AND 6:00 A.M. EXCEPT A PERSON WHO IS CAMPING IN A DEVELOPED RECREATION AREA OR WHO IS VISITING A PERSON CAMPING IN THAT AREA.
- 261.58(v) FISHING IN DESIGNATED SWIMMING AREA.
- 261.58(v) HUNTING FROM A PERMANENT STAND IS PROHIBITED. PLACING OR LEAVING A TEMPORARY STAND IS LIMITED TO 24 HOURS.
- 261.58(v) FISHING BY AID OF TROTLINE, JUG LINES, THROW LINE, NETS, TRAPS OR YO YOS IN ALL LAKES AND PONDS LESS THAN 50 ACRES.
- 261.58(v) COMMERCIAL FISHING.
- 261.58(v) FISHING FROM A BOAT DOCK OR WITHIN 50 FEET OF BOAT RAMP AREA.
- 261.58(v) HUNTING WITHIN THE BOUNDARY OF A DEVELOPED RECREATION AREA.
- 261.58(aa) RIDING, HITCHING, TETHERING OR HOBBLING A HORSE OR OTHER SADDLE OR PACK ANIMAL IN VIOLATION OF POSTED INSTRUCTIONS.

261.58(bb) POSSESSION OR CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE IN VIOLATION OF STATE LAW. POSSESSION OR CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE AT STUART LAKE, KINCAID LAKE, AND CANEY LAKE DAY USE AREAS.

261.53(e) POSSESSION OF GLASS CONTAINERS IN DESIGNATED DAY USE AREAS AND BEACHES INCLUDING STUART LAKE, KINCAID LAKE, AND CANEY LAKE.
