### Golden Quartz Day Use Area Closed Due to County Bridge Replacement

NEVADA CITY, Calif. – The Golden Quartz Day Use Area, a popular swimming section on the South Yuba Trail on the Yuba River Ranger District, will be closed starting Monday, August 29, 2016, while Nevada County replaces the Maybert Road Bridge on Maybert Road at the Canyon Creek crossing, located approximately three miles east of the town of Washington.

Construction is estimated to take place between August 29, 2016 and December 20, 2016. However, environmental factors may impact progress.
