

SWAN CREEK NONMOTORIZED TRAILS

Swan Creek is an 8,488 acre area that provides for year-round nonmotorized dispersed recreation use as it is a designated Semi-Primitive Nonmotorized (SPNM) Area. There are approximately 20 miles of moderately used riding, hiking, and mountain bike trails available. A small parking area (2 vehicles) located at Tin Top. The Bar K Wrangler Camp (a trailhead) is located on west side of Swan Creek trails on Highway 125.
