Occupancy and Use

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 261.50 (a) and (b) and for the protection of public health and safety, the following acts are prohibited on or around the areas of the **Iron Mountain Trail** of the Mount Rogers Ranger District of George Washington and Jefferson National Forests, as indicated on the attached map.

Entering an area which is closed for public health and safety. 36 CFR, 261.53(e)

THIS ORDER EXPIRES DECEMBER 21, 2016.

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from the prohibitions contained in this order:

Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force engaged in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
