



## Silver Creek Fire Update August 29, 2016

**Current Status:** Incident management was transferred to Type IV Incident Commander, Michael St. Martin on Sunday, 28 August. The fire perimeter remains entirely within Sarvis Creek Wilderness on the Yampa Ranger District approx. 1 ½ miles north of Silver Creek Trail. Due to fire inactivity, future updates will occur only when status changes occur. **Updates will be posted as new information becomes available.**

**Planned Events:** The Columbine Wildland Fire Module will continue to monitor the fire. Engines will continue to patrol nearby subdivisions.

**Fire Weather:** Forecasted weather this week calls for partly cloudy skies with scattered showers and thunderstorms through Saturday.
