EMERGENCY FOREST ORDER

National Forest System Roads

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) § 261.50 (b) the following acts are prohibited on the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest

36 CFR 261.54(b) Use by any type of traffic prohibited by the order.

All motorized travel is prohibited on Forest Service Road #237 at the following locations and dates specified below.

Forest Service Road #237 (Standard Creek) from its junction with Forest Development Road #237C (T11S, R1W, Section 12) to the junction of Forest Service Road #9622 (T11S, R1W, SE ¼ Section 7). This restriction will be in effect beginning September 2, 2016, Monday through Thursday 5 AM to 5 PM, and Fridays from 5AM to 3 PM until this order is rescinded. Motorized travel is NOT prohibited on holidays.

Forest Service Road #237 (Standard Creek) from its junction with Forest Development Road #237C (T11S, R1W, Section 12) for a distance of 5.7 miles at (T11S, R1W, NE ¼ Section 7). This location will be clearly marked on the ground. This restriction will be in effect beginning September 16, 2016, Monday through Thursday 5 AM to 5 PM, and Fridays from 5 AM to 3 PM until this order is rescinded. Motorized travel is NOT prohibited on holidays.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until rescinded.
2. This order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
4. Any Federal, State or Local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.



