EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulation 261.50 (a and b), the following acts are prohibited on the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest. This temporary restriction is in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations and will remain in effect from August 31, 2016 through October 31, 2016 unless rescinded earlier.

36 CFR 261.53 – Special Closures: It is prohibited to go into or be upon any area which is closed for the Protection of “Public Health and Safety” (Title 36 CFR 261.53€).

The purpose of this order is to ensure public health and safety from wildfire and during fire suppression activities associated with the Agnes Lake Fire.

This order will remain in effect from August 31, 2016 until October 31, 2016 unless rescinded earlier upon completion of fire suppression activities.

For the purpose of this order, Forest Roads 8210 (Rock Creek), 190 (Lost Creek) and 7473, and trails 1122 (Rainbow Lake) and 1120 (Uphill) are closed for public safety due to fire activity from August 31, 2016 until rescinded. The specific road and trail sections included in this closure follows with a map attachment.

Area Description:

Closed to entry:

Trail 1122, entire length
Trail 1120, entire length
Forest Road 8210, from Forest boundary
Forest Road 190, from junction of frontage road
Forest Road 7473, from its junction with road 190


These trail and road segments are generally located in T25N, R9W; T26N, R10W

Exemptions:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this restriction:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571).
