

**ORDER**  
**FULLER FIRE TEMPORARY AREA/ROAD/TRAIL CLOSURE**  
KAIBAB NATIONAL FOREST  
NORTH KAIBAB RANGER DISTRICT

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and/or (b), the following acts are prohibited in areas as described in this Order on National Forest System lands administered by the Kaibab National Forest, North Kaibab Ranger District in Coconino County in the State of Arizona. The restricted area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

**PROHIBITIONS:**

1. Being in an area, 36 CFR 261.53(e)
2. Being on a trail, 36 CFR 261.55(a)
3. Being on a road, 36 CFR 261.54(e)

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and,
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

**AREA DESCRIBED:**

The boundary of this area closure starts east of Hwy 67 at the South Canyon Trailhead off FR610, heading northeast along South Canyon Trail #6 to the junction with FR 211, then continuing northeast along FR 211 to the junction with FR 8910, then just south of the FR8910 heading east, then along the Saddle Mountain Wilderness boundary, and back to the South Canyon Trailhead off FR 610. Closed roads include FR 211 and the portion of FR 8910 that run north and south in the closure area. Trails closed include those within Saddle Mountain Wilderness: South Canyon Trail #6, Nankoweap Trail #57 and Saddle Mountain Trail #31. "This Order only affects National Forest System Lands."

**PURPOSE:**

This order is needed for public safety due to the Fuller Fire.

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until September 30, 2016, or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.
