FOREST ORDER

STAGE I FIRE RESTRICTIONS

Fire Restriction Areas 685, 686, 687, 688 and 678E

Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System Lands as described below within the Colville National Forest in Areas 685, 686, 687, 688 and 678E as identified in the Colville National Forest Fire Restrictions Plan date, July 6th 2015, signed by the Colville National Forest supervisor on August 31, 2016.

1. **Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire or stove fire.** For the purpose of this order, this restriction includes briquette fires and applies to all National Forest System lands within the Colville National Forest except, persons maintaining pressurized liquid gas stoves or lanterns, which are exempt. (36 CFR 261.52(a) This restriction does not apply to designated campgrounds as described in Exhibit A.
2. **Smoking** For the purpose of this order, smoking is prohibited on all National Forest system lands except within an enclosed vehicle (including a fully enclosed camp trailer) or building, or while stopped in an area at least ten (10) feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable material. (36 CFR 261.52(c)).
3. **No off-road/off-trail vehicle travel** or travel on roads not cleared of standing grass or other flammable materials; no vehicle travel on those FS roads where access has been impeded or blocked by earthen berms, log, boulders, barriers, barricades or gates, or otherwise identified in the Fire Order. Off-road/off-trail travel to access firewood as allowed under firewood permit is exempt.

These restrictions are effective beginning August 31, 2016 at 0001 hrs and will remain in effect until rescinded.

Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit which specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

3. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A
