### **Route to Timothy Lake Closed for Fish Restoration Project**

**Estacada, OR** – Starting the day after Labor Day, September 6, Forest Service road 57 will be closed for the season between Shellrock Creek (FS road 57 and 58 junction) and Timothy Lake for the replacement of the Anvil Creek culvert. A signed detour route will take travelers around the closed section of road 57 to Timothy Lake while the culvert replacement work is underway. FS road 57 will reopen per normal schedule next season.

For travelers from Portland and the Hwy 26 corridor that are heading to the Timothy Lake area, it is recommended that they take Hwy 26 and FS road 42 as usual to the Timothy Lake area without having to rely on the detours.

For visitors coming from the Estacada area and east Clackamas County, the detour route below is available:

- At the FS road 57 and FS road 58 junction at Shellrock Creek, take FS road 58 north and head east for 12.3 miles.
- At FS road 5860 junction, turn south on FS road 5860 for 3.6 miles.
- At junction with FS road 5890, take FS road 5890 for 0.8 miles.
- The FS road 5890 will turn into FS road 5810 and continue for 0.5 miles.
- The FS road 5810 will return you to FS road 57 just west of Timothy Lake. Turn left onto FS road 57, which will take you about 400 feet down the road to Timothy Lake and areas beyond.

A new, larger fish passage culvert capable of handling 100 year flood flows is being installed by Portland General Electric (PGE) at Anvil Creek as part of fisheries enhancements that were negotiated with PGE for their 2010 license for the Clackamas Hydroelectric Project.
