

TEMPORARY AREA CLOSURE ORDER
USDA FOREST SERVICE
WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LANDS RESTRICTION
EAGLE-HOLY CROSS RANGER DISTRICT

For the protection of health and safety to the public pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the White River National Forest, Eagle-Holy Cross Ranger District, Holy Cross Wilderness, Eagle County, in the State of Colorado.

The restricted area is further defined as an area in the Holy Cross Wilderness located at T. 7S R. 81W, NE ¼ Sec 3 along with a portion of Trail #2001 Fall Creek and all off Trail # 2000 Notch Mountain as shown on the attached map.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Going into or being upon the National Forest System lands within the Fall Creek Fire Closure Area: See Attached Map 36 C.F.R. 261.53(e)
2. Being on the closed portion Trail #2001 Fall Creek and Trail #2000 Notch Mountain. See attached map 36 C.F.R 261.53(e).


EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty;
2. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.


This order shall remain in effect until rescinded or until December 31, 2016, whichever event occurs first.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by the fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).
