Science— monitor our new Phenology Trail, part of a National data base, and tour the Southwest Experimental Garden Array (SEGA)

Technology—both old and new, from the 1932 Blackstone Generator to the latest real time data gathering devices.

Engineering—visit the remnants of historic efforts by the Army Corps of Engineers

Art—make paper creations under the direction of Ms. Nita, artist in residence. And maybe a visit to local petroglyphs on Sunday morning.

Math—count and record invertebrates found in Walnut Creek

The cost is \$10/person or \$25 for the whole family. Lunch is provided.

Attendees are invited to camp overnight on Saturday, but must bring their own gear. Water and bathroom facilities are on site and a bonfire is likely after dark.

Directions to Walnut Creek Center: From Prescott take Williamson Valley Road until the pavement ends(24miles) and then keep going straight for another 14 miles on a well maintained dirt road. Just after you cross a steel girder bridge the road will fork, take the left fork, Walnut Creek Road, for another 1.8 miles. The Center will be the first buildings you see on your left.
