Frey Gulch Road Temporary Closure

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) § 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited on the Dillon Ranger District of the White River National Forest, Summit County, State of Colorado (the "Restricted Area").

The Restricted Area is further defined as a section of the Frey Gulch Road (National Forest System Road #66) that is located T. 5 S., R 77 W., SW ¼ Sec 14., and is depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

The Closure Order is necessary to protect the public for health and safety while workers remove and replace an undersized culvert crossing.

PROHIBITIONS:

- 1) All motorized vehicle use is prohibited east of the Restricted Area. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e).


EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force engaged in the performance of an official duty;
- 2) Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This Order will be in effect from September 20th, 2016 and shall remain in effect until rescinded or until September 22, 2016 whichever event occurs first.

Violations of these regulations is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 U.S.C § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3571 and 3559.
