ORDER

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 261.50(b) the following acts are prohibited on designated portions of National Forest Service Roads and Trails, as shown on the attached map, within the Idaho Panhandle National Forests. These restrictions are in addition to those general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR, Part 261, Subpart A, become effective **October 1, 2016**, and will remain in effect until rescinded.

1. Being on the road [Title 36 CFR 261.54(e)].
2. Prohibited to go into or be upon any area which is closed for the protection of Public Health and Safety [Title 36 CFR 261.53(e)].

Being on or using Forest Service Road 334 located in T57N, R5W, Section 7 between the junctions with Forest Service Road 416 and Forest Service Road 1300 is prohibited due to construction activities.

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt:

1. Persons with specific written authorization for the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official emergency duty. Report all emergency access to the Priest Lake Ranger District as soon as possible.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.
4. Contractor and his personnel in the performance of their duties.

RATIONALE: These Emergency Closure restrictions are designed to protect **PUBLIC HEALTH and SAFETY** due to culvert removal and replacement activities utilizing heavy equipment.

PENALTY: Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C 3559 and 3571)

NOTIFICATION: A copy of this order shall be posted in the Forest Supervisor's Office, each District Ranger's office and other appropriate locations as prescribed under Title 36 CFR 261.51.
