Fire Closure

WALLOWA-WHITMAN NATIONAL FOREST MALHEUR NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the area described in this order within the Whitman Ranger District of the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest and portions of the Malheur National Forest from September 8, 2016 to November 30, 2016 unless rescinded or superseded.

1. It is prohibited for any person to be on any road, trail or in the area described in Appendix A of this order. **36 CFR 261.53(e).**

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1.) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- (2.) Any Federal, State or local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

This order supersedes Order No. 2016-0616-Whitman-05 dated September 1, 2016.

Area closure description:

Beginning on South Fork Burnt River Ln. on private property at the fire edge,
 thence proceeding northwesterly along fire perimeter to Road 1230,
 thence proceeding northwesterly on Road 275 to the junction with dozer line at Road 618,
 thence northwesterly on the dozer line to Road 700,
 thence westerly on Road 700 & Road 810 to the County Line,
 thence westerly on the County Line to Road 2652,
 thence proceeding southerly on Road 2652 & fire perimeter to junction with Road 1370
 thence southerly on Road 1370 to junction with Road 430,
 thence southerly on Road 430 to junction with Road 1600,
 thence easterly along north edge of road 16 to junction with Road 1672,
 thence northeasterly on Road 1672 to the Forest Boundary between the Malheur & Wallowa-Whitman
 NF's,
 thence northwest on the Forest Boundary between the two forests to forest trail 1964,
 thence northerly on forest trail 1964 to the Amelia Creek Trailhead,
 thence northerly along Road 6010 and fire perimeter to South Burnt River Ln,
 thence easterly along South Burnt River Ln to point of beginning.

Statement of Need:



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This closure is necessary to provide forest visitors protection from the current hazardous conditions associated with the current fire situation on the Whitman Ranger District. The Rail Fire is actively burning currently.

Enforcement Procedures:

Enforcement will be conducted by FPOs, LEOs and SAs. Discretion will be used in the first couple of days after enacting the order and the preferred method of compliance will be a warning since the goal is to clear the area and protect the public.

Posting:

Posting shall be done by the forest staff or fire personnel assigned to the fire. Posting should be made at all major access point to the area. Posting will also be done at the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest Supervisor’s office in Baker City, OR.
