

MODOC NATIONAL FOREST  
ORDER NO.  
SOUP FIRE EMERGENCY CLOSURE

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b) and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Modoc National Forest. This Order is effective from September 20, 2016, until rescinded.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Soup Fire Closure Area. The Soup Fire Closure Area boundary begins at the intersection of Forest Route 5 with Modoc County Route 64 (T40N, R15E, Sec25), then continues Northerly along the Western edge of Forest Route 5 to its intersection with Forest Road 42N05B (T41N, R15E, Sec36), then continues Easterly along the Southern edge of Forest Road 42N05B to its end at the Pine Creek Trail (15E20), then continues Easterly along the Southern Edge of Pine Creek Trail to the intersection with Summit Trail (15E10) located in T41N, R15E, Sec22, then continues Northerly along the eastern edge of Summit Trail to the intersection with the Owl Creek Trail (15E11), then continues Southerly along the Western edge of the Owl Creek Trail to the intersection with Emmerson Creek Trail (16E05) in T40N, R16E, Sec9, then continues Southerly along the Western edge of Emmerson Creek Trail (16E05) to the intersection with Bear Camp Trail (16E06) located in T39N, R16E, Sec15, then continues Southerly along the Western edge of Bear Camp Trail to the intersection with South Warner Wilderness Boundary (T39N, R16E, Sec22), then continues Westerly along the Wilderness Boundary to the intersection with Mill Creek Falls Trail (15E13) located in T40N, R15E, Sec29, then continues Westerly along the southern edge of Mill Creek Falls Trail to the intersection with Modoc County Route 64, then Westerly along the Southern edge of County Route 64 back to the starting point, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.52(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Soup Fire Closure Area, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
3. Being on Any National Forest System trail within the Soup Fire Closure Area, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.55(a).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
2. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Owners or lessees of private land in the area to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
