**ORDER
TEMPORARY Pinchot FIRE CLOSURE
COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST
MOGOLLON RIM RANGER DISTRICT**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System land within the Coconino National Forest, Mogollon Rim Ranger District, Coconino County, Arizona. The restricted area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Being in the restricted area; **36 CFR §261.53(e).**
2. Being on any road in the restricted area; **36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e).**
3. Being on the trail; **36 C.F.R. § 261.55(a).**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force or other authorized personnel in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a Forest Service permit that specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act.

AREA DESCRIPTION:

The closure area begins at the junction of Forest Roads (FR) 139/FR95. The boundary moves south along FR 139 to the FR 300. From there, the closure moves west along FR 300 to FR 95, and north along FR 95 to the FR 95/FR 719. Lastly, the closure moves along FR 719 and up to the FR 719/FR 95. All perimeter roads (FR 139, 300, 95, 719) are open for travel.

The Order only affects National Forest System lands.

PURPOSE:

This Order is necessary for public health and safety due to fire activity in the restricted area for the management of the Pinchot Fire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order becomes effective when signed and will remain in force until rescinded or until October 31, 2016, whichever event occurs first.
2. This Order rescinds, replaces and supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in that area addressed in Exhibit A.
