


### Map Legend

### Standing Dead Cutting Limitations

**Dead and Standing Fuelwood**

The removal of standing dead trees is limited by species and size according to the following: Diameters are measured at 4 ½ feet above the ground.

- Ponderosa Pine – Only dead, standing trees less than 12 inches in diameter (38 inches in circumference) or less than 15 feet in height may be removed.
- Pinyon Pine – Only dead, standing trees less than 10 inches in diameter (32 inches in circumference) or less than 12 feet in height may be removed.
- Gambel Oak – Only dead, standing trees less than 8 inches in diameter (25 inches in circumference) or less than 12 feet in height may be removed. Standing dead oak may only be removed between June 1 and October 15.
- Juniper - Only dead standing trees less than 20" diameter (62 inches in circumference)
- Aspen – Only dead, standing trees less than 12 inches in diameter (38 inches in circumference) or less than 12 feet in height may be removed. Dead Limbs cannot be cut from live trees.

Standing dead aspen may only be removed between June 1 and September 30.  
Standing dead oak may only be removed between June 1 and October 15.
